Trade Days Festival Rules & Regulations

- An accepted application is a commitment to participate in the festival. **NO REFUNDS** will be made for any reason, including inclement weather. Accepted vendor / exhibitor must exhibit the full three (3) days of the festival.
- Only one (1) vendor / exhibitor allowed per booth.
- Any items that you plan to sell during the festival must be represented in your booth.
- vendor / exhibitor bear the responsibility for all setup and security needs for their exhibits. The Festival does not require vendor / exhibitor to show proof of insurance; however, it is recommended that each vendor / exhibitor be covered under their own insurance. During setup, you **MUST** secure your booth. **Tent weights ARE required**. Fairhope can be windy during this time of year.
- All fire department safety lanes and rules will be observed and strictly enforced at all times. **No generators** are allowed in the show. Battery lighting is acceptable. **Your booth, awning, chairs and all displays must be within your 10' x 12' space.**
- The State of Alabama and Baldwin County require each exhibitor and vendor to purchase a transient license. The details are available from the Baldwin County License inspector at 251-990-4627. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Alabama State tax, Baldwin County tax, and the City of Fairhope taxes as required by law. Tax forms will be provided at registration.
- Owners and Management reserves the right to remove a vendor / exhibitor from the show for conduct deemed unacceptable of the Annual Trade Days Festival.
- All vendors / exhibitors must be set up by 8:30 AM each morning. Vehicles are not allowed on the event field after the festival opens. Vendors / exhibitors vehicles will be allowed on the event field after festival closes each day.

Festival Fees & Information:

- Vendor / Exhibitor Fee.....\$100 (12 x 10 space)
- Double Booth Fee \$175 (12 x 20 space)
- Food Vendor Fee.....\$200 (food court)
- Amusement or Specialty \$200 (space limited)

Logistics:

- Booth Space: 10' x 12'; Tent Size 10' x 10'
- Electricity is not available in event field. Generators are permitted in food court and designated Amusement or Specialty areas.
- Number of Booth Spaces Available: 100
- Single Booths are set up using a quad system. Single booths will have at least 2 sides open to the public. Every booth is a "corner" booth. Double booths have 3 sides, 1 side open to public.
- Music is prohibited per ASCAP & SESAC

Registration/Set-Up:

Registration & Setup begins at 3:00 PM on Thursday, March 30th at The 181 Market. More specific details concerning tent location, set-up and unloading will be provided upon arrival.

Festival Hours are Friday and Saturday 9:00 am till 4:00 pm and Sunday 9:00 am till 2:00 pm
